

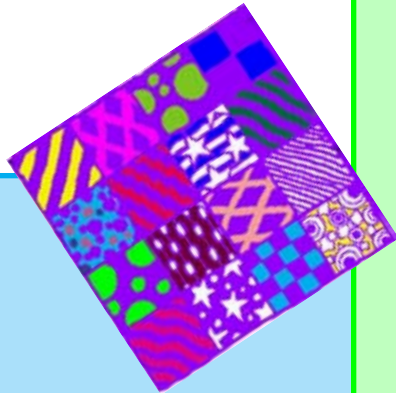


Always My Dad

Here are several activities you and your child can do together after watching this episode.

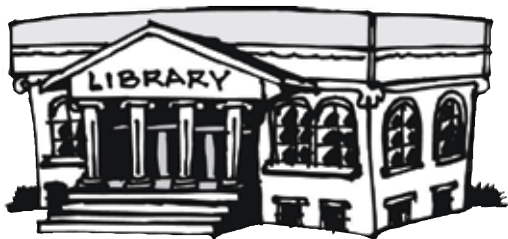


An indoor picnic...
