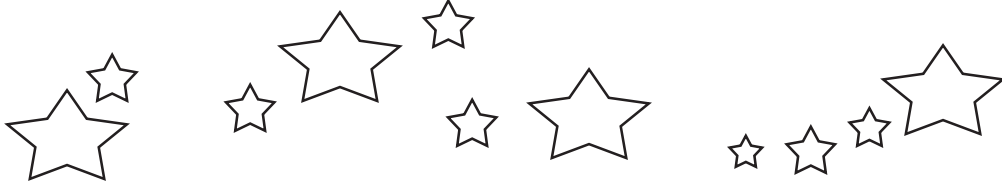




<b>Activity:</b>	<b>Researching slavery and completing a chart comparing responsibilities and lack of freedoms</b>
<b>Episode:</b>	Follow the Drinking Gourd
<b>Learner Objective:</b>	Students will demonstrate an understanding of slavery by researching slavery and completing a chart of what slaves were expected to do and what slaves were not allowed to do.
<b>Materials Needed:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Materials to research slavery</li><li>• one copy for each student of the chart “Things slaves were expected to do and things slaves were not allowed to do” found in this PDF file.</li></ul>
<b>Steps:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Watch the video <i>Follow the Drinking Gourd</i>.</li><li>2. After viewing the video, discuss what the life of a slave was like.</li><li>3. Allow time and provide materials for students to research slavery, focusing on what responsibilities the slaves had and what slaves were not allowed to do.</li><li>4. Ask students to complete the chart individually.</li></ol>
<b>Assessment:</b>	This activity has a built-in assessment with students being able to successfully complete the chart.
