



<b>Activity:</b>	<b>Creating a transportation book</b>
<b>Episode:</b>	Ruth Law Thrills a Nation
<b>Learner Objective:</b>	Students will demonstrate an understanding of transportation by creating a book describing at least four different modes of transportation.
<b>Materials Needed:</b>	<b>Materials to research transportation</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Paper, both writing and construction</li><li>• Pencils</li><li>• Markers or crayons</li><li>• Stapler</li></ul>
<b>Steps:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Discuss many different forms of transportation.</li><li>2. Ask each student to choose four different modes of transportation and allow time to research each.</li><li>3. Have each student create a transportation book, with each page describing a different mode, including pictures.</li><li>4. Allow time for students to share their book with the class.</li></ol>
<b>Assessment:</b>	The assessment for this activity is built in. With the information provided in each book, the teacher will be able to readily assess if the students understand different modes of transportation.
